Presentation by Graham Spiller

Graham has had a lifelong interest in aviation and has amassed a logbook total of over 650 flights in some 178 different types of aircraft.

His affection for the ‘Dakota’ was made during the 75th ‘D-Day’ celebrations where, through his membership of the British Aviation Enthusiast Society, he was able to take part in a ferry flight back to Seattle. His talk covers the wartime and post war career of the aircraft including its operations on D-Day and the Berlin Airlift. He is also a restoration volunteer with hands on work on a Dakota and Catalina at Lee-on-the-Solent airfield.
